Acting Staff Sgt. Hogg reviewed the July and August 2022 policing report:

#### **Crime**

- actively investigating the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder from Marthaville Conservation Area
- 16 sexual assaults reported 9 involved charges, 3 insufficient evidence, 4 declined charges
- 10 sudden deaths 2 investigated by Crime (Child under 4 & overdose)
- Ongoing homicide investigations and disclosure

#### **Property Crimes**

- Break & Enters up YTD 14.3%
- Possession of Stolen Property YTD up 66.7% (Positive catching more)
- Thefts under YTD down 5.1% and Thefts over YTD down 20.5%
- Frauds YTD down 18.5%
- Mischiefs YTD down 17.9%
- Robberies YTD up 100% (2 YTD)

#### CSCU

- Investigated 15 occurrences
- Laid 16 charges and wrote 7 warrants
- Project McNulty concluding 5 parties arrested, 164 grams of meths, \$2130 cash, scales
   & cell seized
- Assisted with fatal motor vehicle collision investigation on Walpole Island
